School Aged Child Care Program

The School Aged Child Care Program is licensed by the Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) to provide quality care to up to 140 girls at the Main Site

Our mission is to build girls' capacity for responsible and confident adulthood, economic independence and personal fulfillment. Our mission is carried out by providing an environment in which girls are taken seriously, where they can interact with peers while gaining new skills and where they can develop relationships with adults who understand their needs and encourage them to ask questions and explore.

Special events and community sharing continues through the year. Members and families enjoy celebrations such as Halloween Haunted House Party, Thanksgiving Friends and Family Feast, and Winter Holidays Celebration. In the community, girls visit places such as area museums, the Meet Me Downtown Festival, Celebration Luncheon Chorus, George's Island, and more.

The School Aged Program offers girls aged 6-13, fun hands-on enrichment activities during a combination of formal and informal time. Informal time gives all members choices of activities such as basketball or jump rope in the gym, reading or working on homework in the library, surfing the internet in the computer lab, or exploring nature and make believe in the game room. Formal time allows girls the opportunity to experience the staff-guided diversity of the programs designed according to the Girls Incorporated National program planning

guidelines, which fall into one or more of the following categories: Careers and Life Planning, Self-Reliance and Life skills, Sports and Adventure, Culture and Heritage, Health and Sexuality, and Leadership and Community Action.

Tuition for both the after-school schedule as well as the school and summer vacation schedule is \$110.00 per week.

To assist families with a service need:

- Income eligible subsidized contracts are available through the Mass. Dept. of Early Childhood Education and Care (EEC). Income eligible families who are working, participation in job training, or attending school, may apply for this subsidy. Using a sliding scale, the fee is based on family size and gross monthly income. This application will be evaluated to be placed on the waiting list.
- We accept child care vouchers from outside agencies such as Child Care Circuit, Department of Transitional Assistance and Community Partnership.
- Income eligible families who are working, participation in job training, or attending school, may apply for this subsidy. Using a sliding scale, the fee is based on family size and gross monthly income. You may call to inquire about availability and qualifications. 1-800-660-2868. Scholarships when available.

HOURS OF PROGRAMMING AND TRANSPORTATION

SCHOOL YEAR:

- Program hours are from 1:45 – 5:30 p.m., Monday – Friday. Girls are transported from their schools to their center in the afternoon.
- Evening transportation is from the program to home and is provided on a space- available basis @ \$6.00 per day one way and \$9.00 both ways.

SCHOOL AND SUMMER VACATIONS:

- Program hours are from 7:30 am – 5:30 pm, Monday – Friday.
- Transportation is available in the morning and evening.
